- There is no meal provided Friday night. You will need to eat before you arrive.
- Youth members who need to leave camp prior to Sunday dismissal must be picked up at the dining hall and signed out by a parent or guardian.
- All participants arriving at camp Friday night should be in uniform with the appropriate outdoor wear which includes boots, gloves, hat, and warm jacket. Avoid sneakers and jeans and denim jackets to stay warm and dry the entire weekend.
- Prescription medications for youth participants need to be given to the medical staff upon registering in with written instruction for use. If the medication is to be administered by the youth, give this information to the medical staff as well.
