NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING (NYLT)
J. WARREN CUTLER SCOUT RESERVATION

Dear Scouters,

Because the Boy Scouts of America believes the best youth leaders are trained leaders, it has developed **National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT)**.

N.Y.L.T. teaches leadership skills designed to develop youth leaders. It is a **demanding** week-long outdoor leadership training course, taught by youth staff, guided by adults.

Participants are organized into patrols. Since this is an outdoor event at Camp J. Warren Cutler in Naples, NY it is required the Scout possess skills in fire building, cooking, camping and hiking. They sleep outdoors, cook their own meals, and learn skills and methods that will enhance the youth leaders effectiveness in his position within his home troop.

To get the most out of NYLT, participants should have command of basic Scoutskills and the experience and desire to learn leadership skills. For that reason, participants must be: First Class Scouts; at least 13 years old and **be recommended by their Scoutmaster**. Each youth is expected to live by the Scout Oath and Law, take part in hands-on activities and keep a notebook of all course presentations.

It is recommended that participants NOT attend camp the week prior to NYLT, so they will have the energy to complete the course.
