**BE SURE TO READ THIS IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

**CAMP LEADERSHIP** - All leaders who are responsible for the group must be registered members of the BSA. A minimum of two qualified adults will be in charge of the unit during the entire period of the unit's stay in camp. At least one of these leaders must be over 21; the other may be a responsible leader 18 or older. All leaders must file a Massawepie Scout Camps Adult Leader Form, approved by the troop's Committee Chair or Chartered Organization.

**BILLING INFORMATION** - In November you will receive your 1<sup>st</sup> invoice. You will need to commit to the number of Scouts and adults that you will be bringing by returning a copy of the invoice along with a \$25 non-refundable deposit for the number of Scouts and adults that you want to reserve space for, no later than December 15. **Space will only be reserved for the number of Scouts and adults for which you pay at this time.** Send a separate check, and only one check, from your troop account to cover camp fees. Be sure to specify on the invoice the number of Scouts that you are paying for.

A 2<sup>nd</sup> invoice will be sent in early February. At this time, an additional \$50 per Scout and adult will be invoiced. This payment will be due March 1. Send only one check from your troop account to cover camp fees. Be sure to specify the number of Scouts that you are paying for. In weeks where the Dining Hall has already been filled by prior reservations, the addition of youth or adults will generally be made on a first-requested, first-added basis, **after** considering requests to add new Webelos cross-overs. Preference will be given to youth over adults.

A final invoice will be sent in mid-April, with final payments due **NO LATER THAN** May 15. Any payments received after May 15 will be subject to the \$25 per person late fee. Webelos crossing over after May 15 will pay the regular fee. After May 15, preference will be given to youth over adults for available Dining Hall space.

**ADDITIONAL PAYMENT INFORMATION**

**IF MAKING RESERVATION PRIOR TO DECEMBER 15, 2009**

Enclose with your application a payment of \$50 to hold a 2010 Massawepie Scout Camp reservation. ***This fee is non-refundable but will be applied to your total fees.*** To continue to hold the reservation, a \$25 per camper (Scout and Adult) deposit will be due December 15, 2009, and a second \$50 per Scout and adult deposit will be due on March 1, 2010. ***Payments are non-refundable (except as noted below) but can be transferred to new campers.***

**IF MAKING RESERVATION AFTER DECEMBER 15, 2009**

Enclose with your application a payment of \$25 per camper (youth & adult) reservation deposit. ***Payments are non-refundable (except as noted below) but can be transferred to new campers.*** To continue to hold the reservation, a \$50 per Scout and adult deposit will be due on March 1, 2010.

**IF MAKING RESERVATION AFTER MARCH 1, 2010**

Enclose with your application a payment of \$75 per Scout and \$75 per adult reservation deposit. ***Payments are non-refundable (except as noted below) but can be transferred to new campers.***

**THE BALANCES OF ALL CAMPING FEES ARE DUE BY MAY 15, 2010.**

**CAMPERSHIPS** are available for Seneca Waterways Council members participating at Massawepie Scout Camp. Campership forms are due to the Council Servicer by **April 15, 2010.**

**PAYMENT SCHEDULE: All payments are due at the Council Servicer payable to Seneca Waterways Council**

**December 15<sup>th</sup>** Initial **non-refundable** \$25 per person (Scout & Adult) fee is due.  
**March 1<sup>st</sup>** Second **non-refundable** payment of \$50 per Scout fee and adult is due.  
**May 15<sup>th</sup>** Final payment is due in full for all campers (youth & leaders).

**REFUND POLICY** - **ALL fees paid are non-refundable** but may be transferred to a new camper. PARTIAL REFUNDS will only be considered for cancellations due to medical reasons or summer school. Medical cancellations will require a doctor's note; summer school cancellations will require a note from a guidance counselor or other school official. The \$25 non-refundable registration fee will not be returned. After June 30, contract commitments increase the non-refundable amount to \$50 regardless of the reason for the cancellation. Requests for partial refunds must be made no later than August 31. Requests made after that date will not be considered.

**MEDICAL FORMS** - Medical forms are required for every person in camp. The council must keep these medical forms. Be sure to make copies of the form before you come to camp. Be prepared to leave a copy of the medical form at camp. Keep the original in a safe place. **COPIES CANNOT BE MADE AT CAMP, AND THEY CANNOT BE PROVIDED AT A LATER TIME.**

**CAMPSITE POLICY** - Based on the number of Scouts and leaders you make payment for by May 15, troops will be assigned a campsite. We reserve the right to make changes necessary to best accommodate campers.
