**BE SURE TO READ THIS IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

**CAMP LEADERSHIP** – All leaders who are responsible for the group must be registered members of the BSA. A minimum of two qualified adults will be in charge of the unit during the entire period of the unit’s stay in camp. At least one of these must be over 21; the other may be a responsible 18 or older. All leaders must file a Camp Babcock Hovey Adult Leader Form, approved by the Troop’s Committee Chair or Chartered Organization.

**BILLING INFORMATION** – In February you will receive an invoice detailing your total for camp. You will need to commit to the number of Scouts and adults that you will be bringing by returning a copy of the invoice along with a \$100.00 non-refundable deposit for the number of Scouts and a \$50.00 non-refundable deposit for the number of adults that you want to reserve space for, no later than March 12, 2010. **Space will only be reserved for the number of Scouts and adults for which you pay for at this time.** Send a separate check, and only one check from your troop account to cover camp fees. Be sure to specify on the invoice the number of Scouts that you are paying for.

A final invoice will be sent in April, with final payments due **NO LATER THAN** May 21, 2010. Any payments received after May 21<sup>st</sup> will be subject to the \$25.00 per person late fee. Webelos crossing over after May 21<sup>st</sup> will pay the regular fee.

**ADDITIONAL PAYMENT INFORMATION**

**IF MAKING RESERVATION PRIOR TO DECEMBER 31, 2009**

Enclose with your application a payment of \$100.00 to hold a 2010 Camp Babcock Hovey reservation. **This fee is non-refundable but will be applied to your total fees.** To continue to hold the reservation, a \$100.00 per Scout and \$50.00 per adult (one free per unit) deposit will be due on March 12, 2010. **Payments are non-refundable (except as noted below) but can be transferred to new campers.**

**IF MAKING RESERVATION AFTER MARCH 12, 2010**

Enclose with your application a payment of \$100.00 per Scout and \$50.00 per adult (one free per unit) reservation deposit. **Payments are non-refundable (except as noted below) but can be transferred to new campers.**

**THE BALANCE OF ALL CAMPING FEES ARE DUE BY MAY 21, 2010**

**CAMPERSHIPS** are available for Seneca Waterway Council members participating at Camp Babcock Hovey. Campership forms are due to the Council Service Center by **April 15, 2010.**

**PAYMENT SCHEDULE: All payments are due at the Council Service Center payable to Seneca Waterways Council**

- December 31<sup>st</sup>** Initial non-refundable \$100.00 Camp Babcock Hovey reservation is due.
- March 12<sup>th</sup>** Non-refundable payment of \$100.00 per Scout and \$50.00 per adult (one adult free per unit)
- May 21<sup>st</sup>** Final payment is due in full for all campers (youth & leaders)

**REFUND POLICY** – All fees paid are non-refundable but may be transferred to a new camper. **PARTIAL REFUNDS** will only be considered for cancellations due to medical reasons or summer school. Medical cancellations will require a doctor’s note; summer school cancellations will require a note from a guidance counselor or other school official. \$50.00 of all fees paid will not be refunded regardless of the reason for the cancellation. Request for partial refunds must be made no later than August 31<sup>st</sup>. **Requests made after that date will not be considered.**

**MEDICAL FORMS** – Medical forms are required for every person in camp. The council must keep these medical forms. Be sure to make copies of the form before you come to camp. Be prepared to leave a copy of the medical form at camp. Keep the original in a safe place. **COPIES CANNOT BE MADE AT CAMP, AND THEY CANNOT BE PROVIDED AT A LATER TIME.**

**CAMPSITE POLICY** – Based on the number of Scouts and leaders you make payment for by May 21<sup>st</sup>, troops will be assigned a campsite. We reserve the right to make changes necessary to best accommodate campers.
